
This Deed of trust executed on this 7th day of February 2005 (07-02-2005)

All assets of the Trust shall be held by the Trustees in the name the Trust.

2. NATURE OF THE TRUST: -

The Trust shall be Charitable Trust, having no commercial or profit motive. The properties, Securities, Moneys and income or profits thereof shall be applied in India solely for the purpose of the Trust without any discrimination of race, religion, cante or sex and no portion thereof shall be distributed among the trustees.

3. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:-

The Principal objects of the Trust shall be as follows:

The Trust is established for the Churitable and benevolent purpose of promoting the physical, Mental, Social and Moral Advancement of all people without distinction of custe, creed, color or community. This is proposed to be done in the following fields in the manner specified.

A. EDUCATION:-

- (a) To establish, maintain, run, develop and improve or to make donations to educational institutions, technical, industrial or otherwise including schools, colleges, polytechnics, research associations, institutions, engineering college. Medical college, agricultural institutions, laboratories, workshop etc., and to run hostels for any or all of the afore.
- (b) To provide relevant education, technical or otherwise, to physically, mentally or socially handicapped children, women, and others, without any distinction of caste, creed, colour or community so as to integrate themselves in the society, and to create a feeling that they are wanted and loved;
- (c) To provide formal or nonformula education for all children and adults, without any distinction of caste. Creed Colour or community.
- (d) To grant scholarships or loans or any other kind of assistance in cash or in kind to deserving poor students towards tuition fees, clothing, books, hostel fees, and other incidental expenses for the purpose of pursuing their studies;
- (e) To establish, maintain, run, develop, extend or grant donations to libraries, reading rooms, recreation centers, and other facilities as are calculated to be of use in impurting education to Indian public.

- (f) To organize talks seminars, camps, and plutforms of similar nature to rekindle the thoughts and encourage participation of the student community in such talks and also to bring about greater spiritual awakening among the general public.
- (g) To organize fairs, exhibitions, dramas, and other such performances, freely or by collecting funds for the benefit of individual students or for the student community in seneral.
- (h) To organize Educational or similar tours for the benefit of the students, their purents and the general public.
- (i) To conduct or organize study groups, and lecture series.

B. HEALTH CARE: -

- (a) To construct, establish, maintain run, develop, improve hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, maternity homes, rescue homes, to help treat all people without any distinction of caste creed colour or community at costs affordable to them, or even free of cost;
- (b) To provide health care to the poor, distressed, afflicted, and the physically, mentally or socially, handicapped persons. Which shall include maternal and child health care, environmental sanitation, control of communicable diseases geniatric care etc.,

C. SOCIO- ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT: -

- (a) To carry out objects of general public utility and security such as village supplement rural reconstruction public health and hygiene, community development weither of women and children, promotion of cottage industries, self employment schemes etc., and to start, establish conduct, take over maintain and manage and help any institution considered necessary to secure these objects e.g. Orphanages, Old age homes etc.,
- (b) To uplift the rural public in the matter of literacy self employment aware ness of health child care, women welfare family welfare and both control programmers, control and eradication of drug addiction etc.,

D. EMERGENCY RELIEF

To give food clothing medicines, cash grants and any other help that may be necessary to the poor and afflicted people in distress, affected by natural calumities such as earthquake floods, famine etc.

E ANY OTHER ACTIVITY

(A) To build, erect and construct and to aid and assist in the construction of houses, tenements and hostels for the benefit of poor and the children or destitute who have lost their near and dear ones in accidents in the hazardous industries.

- (F) To arrange seminars and camps to bring out the awareness among people regarding matters affecting their health hazards of their working conditions and other things.
- (G) This Trust will not interfere in any political action will not join any political party
- (H) To support the government development program
- (I) To get finance subsidy through the government and utilize it for the uplift of the rural people.
- (J) To try to reach the rural people about health education and protect them from the
- (K) To support the farmers by introducing the modern methods of their cultivation and benefits.
- (L) To help the rural students by giving free books and uniforms and develop the rural education s standard.
- (M) To provide a home for destitute women and give them training in small scale industries.
- (N) To help the orphana by forming a orphanage and provide them food shelter dress and education
- (O) To conduct medical camp to help the rural people
- (P) To help the rural people in family planning by explaining the merits of small family and demerits of large family.
- (Q)To insist the rural women about the importance of education and make necessary arrangements for the women's education.
- (R) To develop a library where sociological research in the above said areas can be
- (S) To help the rural people in solving their problems in a peaceful manner.
- (T) To engage in any other activity which has not between specifically, mentioned so far which shall promote the Trusts primary objective of physical mental social and moral development of all people without any distinction of caste creed colour or community.

F. CO-OPERATION WITH OTHER AGENCIES: -

To work in co-ordination with any other Trust or institution having similar aims and objectives aid assist other agencies or to undertake any activity entrusted or delegated to it by effectively carrying out such activities in whole or in part as per the capabilities.

4) SPECIAL OBJECTIVES

- 1. To give shelter to the Orphanage child.
- 2. To give shelter for old age people.
- 3. To give shelter and give training in different occupation for the handicapped person.
- To bring legal opportunities for widows to stand in the society for all legal and religious status.
- 5. To give importance for Agriculture which well uplift the rural people.
- 6. To starting training and help for useful sick person.
- To start a public school for every type of slandered which will not have any govt.,
 support
- 8. To bring people problem to the notice of the Covt. by way of emulation work
- To bring everywhere amount people for civic knowledge in way of coir bags to the kept in public place which will bring our work for Govt. and hygienic for people.

5. PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE FOUNDATION: -

- I. The foundation will have its registered office until otherwise determined at Office Address no. 29, Kumarapillai Street, Kottucherry, Karaikal, Pondicherry State – 609
- II. The foundation may locate its principal office and branches at Karaikal or such other places in India as the Trustees may desire from time to time.

6. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

6.1 The Trust shall be administered by a Board of Trustees consisting of 3 Permanent Trustees. The permanent Trustees may nominate/co-opt. not more than 5 additional Trustees.

- 6.2 The above mentioned 3 Founder trustees shall be the first trustees of the foundation and permanent of the same. They shall hold office for life or until resignation.
- 6.3 The additional trustees shall hold office for a period of 3 years from the date of their nomination the retiring trustees shall be eligible for re-appointment.
- 6.4 On the death or resignation of a permanent trustee the remaining permanent trustees shall appoint a new permanent trustee in his /her place.
- 6.5 The permanent trustee shall elect a chairman cum director, a secretary and a treasurer from among themselves to hold office for a term of three years. They shall be eligible for re-appointment.

The first office bearers are as follows.

Chairman cum Founder P. SAKTHIVEL
Secretary S. SELVAPOOZHANY
Treasurer P. SURESH

6.6 None of the trustees shall be entitled to draw any remuneration.

7. BANK ACCOUNTS:-

All accounts opened for the Trust shall be op [elated jointly by chairman ours Founder and secretary who shall be authorized by the Executive committee.

8. POWER OF THE TRUSTEES:-

- 8.1 The Chairman shall be the chief executive of the foundation and shall Have the general power to conduct the affairs and management of the foundation.
- 8.2 The Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer shall exercise such power as may be delegated to them by the board of trustees.
- 8.3 The trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the trust, its institutions properties and funds and to do all acts deeds and things as are calculated to promote the objects for the which this foundation is established. They shall be entitled to act even if their number is reduced to less than five for the purpose of filling up any vacancy in the Board of Trustees.
- 8.4 Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing the trust shall have the following powers and authorities for the purpose of the trust.
 - a) To invest the finds of the trust in accordance with the provision of section 13 (1)(d) read with section 13(5) of the Income Tax Act 1961.
 - b) To acquire by purchase gifts exchange lease hire or otherwise lands buildings movable and properties of every other descriptions.
 - To sell mortgage grant lease hire or otherwise alienate the properties of the trust.
 - d) To borrow money with or without security and repay the same.

- e) To enter into all contracts on behalf of the trust and to vary and rescind them.
- f) To open bank accounts and provide for their operations as the trustees may deem fit from time to time.
- g) To receive gifts grants endowments and donations in cash or in kind from persons institutions and authorities within India and outside India.
- To raise money from the public by organizing benefit performance, collection and subscription and donations bringing out publications and in other ways.
- i) To institute, prosecute and defend all suits legal and other proceedings.
- j) To appear and act before courts. Tribunals Governments, Tax and public authorities.
- To appoint terminate dismiss suspend and otherwise deal with the employees of the trust and its institutions
- To apply the properties and funds of the trust for all or any of the objects for which the trust is established as may be determined by the Board of Trustees from time to time.
- m) To decide from time to time the works to be undertaken in fulfilling the objects of the trust.
- n) To incur all the necessary expenses connected with the trust and its projects.

9. PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUST: -

- 9.1 The trustees may meet as often as may be necessary for the conduct of the business of
- 9.2 The quorum required for a meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be two in the case of meeting adjourned for want quorum the members present shall themselves constitute a quorum subject to a minimum of two.
- 9.3 The chairman of the Trust and in his absence or inability any other trustee elected as the Chairman shall preside over the meeting of the trust.
- 9.4 All decisions of the Board of trustees may be taken by a simple majority except as expressly provide for otherwise herein. The Chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to a casting vote in the event of equality of votes at a meeting.
- 9.5 At least one week notice in writing shall be given for every meeting for the Board of Trustees provided however, the Chairman shall have power to convene a meeting at shorter notice for transacting any business considered by him to be urgent.
- 9.6 The business of the trust may also be transacted by circulation of paper.
- 9.7 The President shall maintain the proper record of minutes of the Board of Trustees.
- 9.8 No vacancy of the Board of Trustees and no irregularity in appointing any trustee shall invalidate any act or decision of the Board of Trustees.

10. DELEGATION:-

- 10.1 The Board of Trustees may from time to time delegate to one or more of their body or any other person or committee/s such of their powers and duties as they deem fit. Subject nevertheless to their retaining ultimate control and supervision.
- 10.2 The Trust may constitute an advisory body at Regional/National level with eminent men as its members and seek their advice regarding the activities of the trust keeping the objectives of the trust in perspective.

11. FRAMING OF RULES AND BY-LAWA:-

The Board of Trustees may frame rules and by-laws for the management of the trust its institutions, properties and proceedings of the trust and amend or rescind them as it deems fit.

12. ACCOUNT AND ACCOUNTING YEAR:-

- 12.1 The trust shall maintain account regularly. The account shall be audited by a chartered Accountant every year according to legal requirements.
- 12.2 The year of the account of the trust shall be from the first day of April of a year to the 31'st day of March of the following year. The first year account shall be closed at the end of March 2005.

13 AMENDMENTS OF THE TRUST DEED:-

The trustees shall make such amendments as they find necessary to the trust deed and the rules and regulations within the frame work of the Trust but no amendments of the Trust deed or rules and regulations shall be made which may prove repugnant to the provisions of the section 2(5) 11-13 and 80 G of the Income Tax Act 1961. That is not contravening the provisions of the Income Tax Act applicable to Charitable Trust.

14. INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUNDS:-

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall be transferred to another charitable trust, society association, organization whose objects are similar to those under section 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961.

15. INDEMNITY:-

The Trustees shall be kept indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any action, claim demand or liability arising against them for anything done by them in good faith pursuant to the power of authority vested in them under these presents.

16. IRREVOCABILITY AND AMENDMENTS TO THE TRUST:-

- 16.1 The trust hereby created is irrevocable
- 16.2 The provisions of this deed may be amended if the Board of Trustees an unanimously or by not less than 3/4th majority so decide
- 16.3 It is hereby made clear that the Board of Trustees shall have power to make from time to time all such amendments as may be required to secure recognition, exemptions and relief under income Tax Act or other fiscal laws or as may be found necessary for the smooth working of the trust.
- 16.4 Provided that the character of the Trust as a public charitable trust shall not be altered.

17. ACCEPTANCE OF THE TRUST: -

The Permanent Trustees above named accept the trust.

There is no other movable or immovable properties other than initial amount Rs.5,000/-(Rupees Five Thousand only).
